TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that the Township Board will meet at the **Township Hall, 7008 Marsh Rd, Cottrellville, MI 48039 on Thursday December 6, 2018 at 7:00 pm** for the purpose of reviewing said special assessment roll and hearing any objections thereto.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that appearance and protest at this hearing is required in order to appeal the amount of the special assessment to the Michigan Tax Tribunal, if an appeal should be desired. A property owner or party of interest, or his/her agent, may appear in person at the hearing to protest the special assessment or may file his/her appeal by letter delivered to the Township Clerk by Thursday December 6, 2018 at 7:00 pm and his/her personal appearance shall not be required. The property owner or any person having an interest in the property, subject to the proposed special assessment, may file an appeal of the special assessment with the Michigan Tax Tribunal within thirty-five (35) days after the confirmation of the proposed Special Assessment roll, if the special assessment was protested at this hearing. Proposed confirmation to be December 12, 2018 at the regular Township Board Meeting.
